Infrastructural initiatives:

The institution has installed solar panels for generating electricity. It has been operational since 2022, the amount of energy generated through alternative sources was units.

All the classrooms, laboratories washroom, use LED Lights which reduce electricity consumption. As per the recommended on the energy per audit report ceiling fan (50watt) is replaced with BLDC based energy efficient fan (28watts) in our smart clay room.

The Green Committee has been educating students through Quotations & by arranging seminars to avoid waiting for electricity & students have been following instructions accordingly. Where ever there is less occupancy for the students they are instructed to switch off extra lights or fans and insist they use natural light. Management of the various types of Degradable and Non-Degradable waste

The institution is centralized, transparent and well-planned. Waste management system.

Solid waste Management:

Solid waste is generated from there the sources from the colleges Examination, library and canteen, office, & store.

The paper waste generated from Examination & library and office are disposed of through the paper waste vendor. The paper vendors sell it to the agencies which manage the process of recycling.

Metal Scrap generated is deposited to scrap dealers.

Degradable & Non-Degradable wastes are collected separately and deposited at the Sarapancha office of Rondapalli within 8-10 days of collection. Hazardous chemicals & radioactive waste management. No such waste is generated by this college.

Liquid waste:

The wastewater is deposited in our septic tanks.

Biomedical waste management:


The institution does not actually generate any bio-medical waste during its practical periods. However, there are two probable Sources identified which may generate bio-medical waste.

(1) Ladies' washrooms:

The used sanitary napkins were Immersed by the incinerator machine provided in Girl's common room.

(2) Practical:

Human Anatomy Physiology, Master degree ecology experiments generate some isolated body organs, cotton, gauge, needle & this is collected separately & handed over to the Sarapancha office.

Water Conservations

The college makes efforts to conserve water through rainwater harvesting routed to an underground collector tank. Rainwater from differentiation collecting areas flows into the underground collector built for the purpose. This is to ensure adequate recharge of groundwater level. The 2 bore well and one open well is used as sources of water. The water collection & distribution is organized in a way that drinking water is stored separately then others.

6 overhead tanks(1000lit.) are used for Storing water, Drinking ten cleaning, and washing purpose. 10 no. of tanks with 2008 lit Capacity for fire extinguishers.
