Attached to the audited financial statements for the year 2023-24) 1. Significant Accounting Policies: Accounting assumption: The accounts of the college are prepared under the historical cost convention in accordance with applicable accounting standards using the accrual system of accounting. 2. Expenditure of capital nature have been capitalized at cost, which comprises purchase price (net of rebates and discounts), and directly attributable cost of bringing the assets to their working condition for their intended use including applicable borrowing costs. All upgradation/ enhancements are generally charged off as revenue expenditure unless they bring similar significant additional benefits. 3. Depreciation has been provided under written down value method in the prescribed procedure by considering the quality and usage of the asset. 4. Confirmations in respect of payables and receivables from suppliers, buyers and other third parties have not been obtained and verified, the management does not expect any material discrepancies on this account. 5. Revenue Recognition: Tuition fees collections from students are assumed to accrue non-uniformly throughout the year and accordingly, an adhoc 10-15% of the fees has been treated as tuition fees received in advance, which will be transferred to revenue in the next year. 6.
