





Jeypore College of Pharmacy started in the year 2001. The institute is managed by Banagiri Development Trust. It plays an important and integral part in the Foundation's mission as it endeavors to provide quality education for its community.
- The Parties have appreciated each other's objectives in promoting Excellence inter alia III. in common area of interest, imparting knowledge and skills required to operate in the area of Academic, Research and Training and are desirous of putting the broad terms of the intentions into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for the areas identified for co-operation and commit to co-operate to the fullest extent by mutual understanding.

NOW THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- Both the Parties have hereto identified the following areas where they agree to L. cooperate to the fullest extent mutually:
 - a. Workshop/ Seminar and Conference/Virtual exchange of Classes/Faculty Exchange Program Virtually: Jeypore College of Pharmacy, Vana Vihar, Rondapalli, Jeypore, Dist-Koraput, Odisha or ARKA JAIN University could participate as Faculty / Speaker Workshops, Seminars, Continuing Education and Training programmes conducted by both parties for Faculty Members, Research Scholars and students.
 - b. Both parties agree to undertake students and involved them for Joint Research Projects which are mutually beneficial. However selected M. Pharm/U.G. students will get opportunity to pursue their research projects at the virtual guidance of Jeypore College of Pharmacy, Vana Vihar, Rondapalli, Jeypore, Dist-Koraput, Odisha.
 - Extend help and cooperation in developing the Curriculum of Continuing Education Programmes on such terms as may be mutually agreed to, including C. 1 Joint Meetings of Curriculum Development Committees/bodies.
 - Both parties will take selected students of Pharmacy for / Internship training d. every year with the students as agreed mutually by the parties.
 - Absorption / Employment for the students will be purely at the discretion of both е. parties (As per their requirement).
 - Students of Both Parties, if interested, can enroll for the pharmacy course run f. by both parties by fulfilling their admission norms at a fee structure mutually agreed upon by the parties and the standards set by their Pharmacy Board and other governmental agencies.

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Faculty Development Programmes: IL.

Faculty Development Programs are an essential component in standardising classroom teaching all over the country. These programs help the teachers update them with the students' expectations, the institution's expectations, and proper penetration in imparting relevant areas of specialisation. The fellow members of the corporation could contribute to the faculty development program of both institutions in the domain of Allied Health Science and Pharmacy.

Non-Binding Nature of the MOU Ш.

Nothing in this MOU shall be construed as creating any contract, partnership, agency or other legal relationship between the parties. The acts/performance and actions taken by either party in furtherance of their respective activities of operation shall not bind the other except to the extent provided under this MOU. The acts performed and actions taken by either party that do not fall under the MOU shall have a binding effect on the other to the extent they are reduced to writing and the prior consent of the other party is obtained. Also, the MOU does not restrain or preclude parties from entering into similar MOUs with any other organisation during currency or the extended currency of this MOU.

Terms and Termination of the MOU IV.

The MOU shall come into force immediately upon its signing by the parties. The MOU will be in force for an initial period of five (5) years. MOU may be extended further on the mutually agreed terms. ARKA JAIN University or Jeypore College of Pharmacy, Vana Vihar, Rondapalli, Jeypore, Dist-Koraput, Odisha shall not have any right to claim extension or renewal of contract.

Suppose any provision of this MOU is held invalid, unenforceable or illegal for any reason. In that case, this MOU will remain otherwise in full force apart from that provision(s) which shall be deemed deleted.

VII. Assignment & Sub-Letting

Neither party shall assign or sub-let any of its rights and obligations hereunder whether in whole or in part without the prior written consent of the other.

VIII. Confidentiality

Both Parties agree to treat the contents of this MOU and any valuable information provided, developed, found or acquired in the process or performance of this MOU, as confidential and agree and undertake that the Parties shall not disclose the contents of the same to any third party without the prior consent of the other Party unless such information is required to be disclosed under the applicable law, or in pursuance of the order of a competent court, tribunal or other regulatory authority exercising valid jurisdiction. In such case of disclosure of confidential information, the disclosing party shall promptly notify the other party in writing of such disclosure.

For purposes of this MOU, "Confidential Information" includes information that: (i) is sufficiently secret to derive economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use; and / or (ii) is the subject of efforts that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy or confidentiality.

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Provided that upon the expiration, cancellation, or termination of this MOU, each party shall, upon the written request of the other party, return or destroy, to the satisfaction of the other Party, all Confidential Information, documents, manuals and other materials specified by the other Party.

IX. Governing Law

The MOU shall be interpreted in accordance with and governed by the applicable laws in India.

X. Dispute Resolution



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
